#### **ABOUT THE CAMPUS**

The **St. Thomas Training College** (STTC) has been set up by the Mar Thoma Church Educational Society, a Society registered under the Travancore – Cochin Literary, Scientific and Charitable Societies Registration Act, 1055 as No.S.23 of 1966. STTC which strives to prepare teachers for teaching in the class rooms of tomorrow started functioning from July 2005.

### **HOW TO APPLY**

Application forms are available from the College Office on payment of **Rs.250/-** or can be downloaded from the Website [www.sttctvm.org](http://www.sttctvm.org) and hard copy to be given to the College with a payment mentioned above as Demand Draft or Cash.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- A Degree with 50% of Marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's Degree in the subjects concerned.
- The minimum requirement of marks for admission to B.Ed course is 50% for Part III/50% in aggregate (Part I + Part II + Part III together) in Bachelor's Degree (Science/Arts subjects) or 50% marks in Post Graduation in the concerned subject.
- Ranking of candidates shall be on the basis of marks obtained for Part III.
- Candidates who have taken their Degree from a University other than Kerala University should produce an Eligibility Certificate (from University of Kerala) and Migration Certificate (from the University where the candidate last attended the Qualifying Examination) at the time of admission.

### **FEES DETAILS**

The tuition fee has to be paid at the time of admission and the withdrawal of a candidature during an academic year is not generally allowed. If a student has to withdraw for any reason, no amount will be refunded under any circumstances after the classes are started in the College. If a student provisionally admitted wants to withdraw from the admission with prior written intimation received prior to the reopening of the College, a minimum of 50 % of fees will be deducted.

Those who do not pay fees by the prescribed date are liable to lose the chance of getting admitted and then the seats are liable to be filled by other applicants or by late applicants.
